



William Goetzmann is a finance professor at the Yale School of Management and the faculty director of the school's International Center for Finance. His research topics include stock markets, hedge funds, alternative investments and behavioral finance. He has written or co-authored a number of books, including *Modern Portfolio Theory and Investment Analysis* (Wiley, 2014) and *Money Changes Everything: How Finance Made Civilization Possible* (Princeton, 2016). His research on hedge funds and their strategies is widely cited in academia and practice. He received the 2018 James R. Vertin Award for outstanding research from the CFA Institute Research Foundation.
